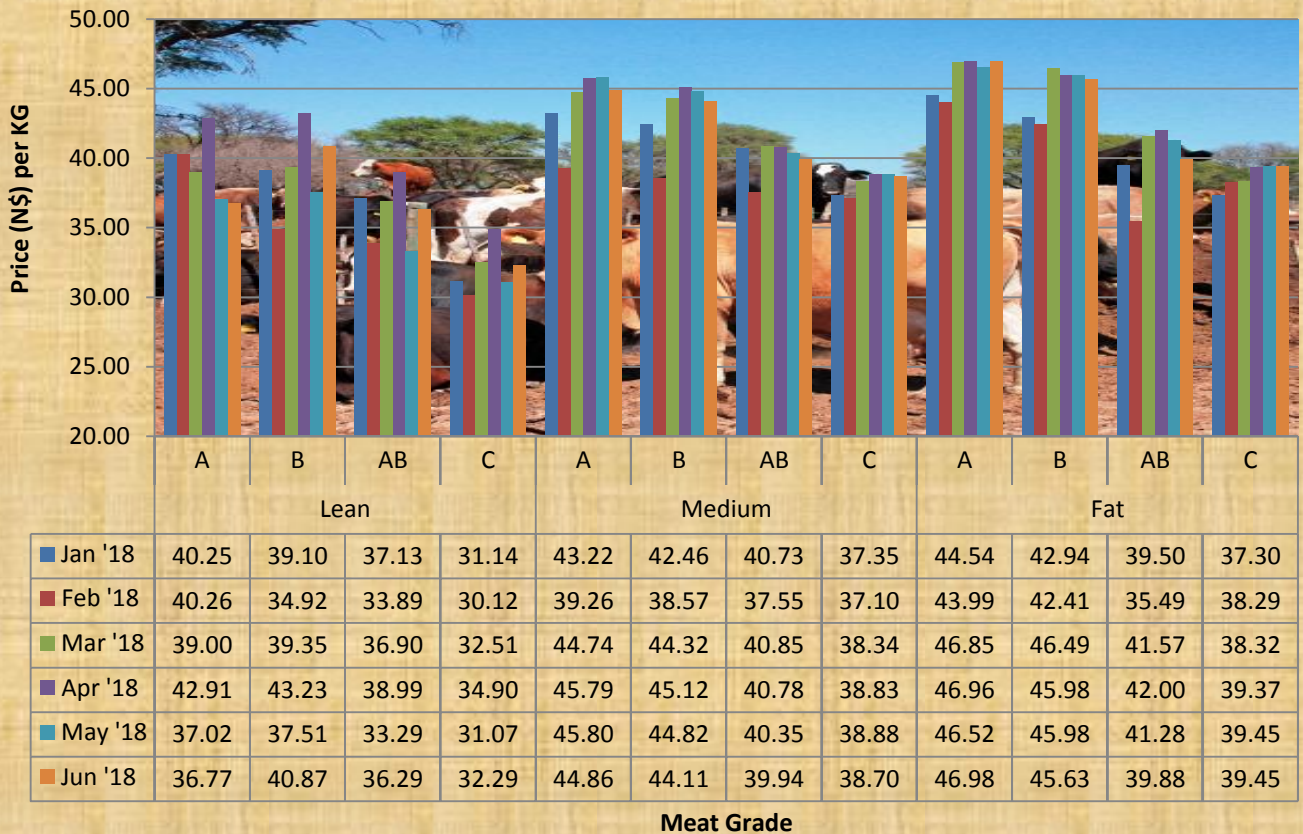
## COMMODITY PRICE (N\$ per unit) BULLETIN

### Self-Quarantined Beef Products Delivered to NCA Abattoir

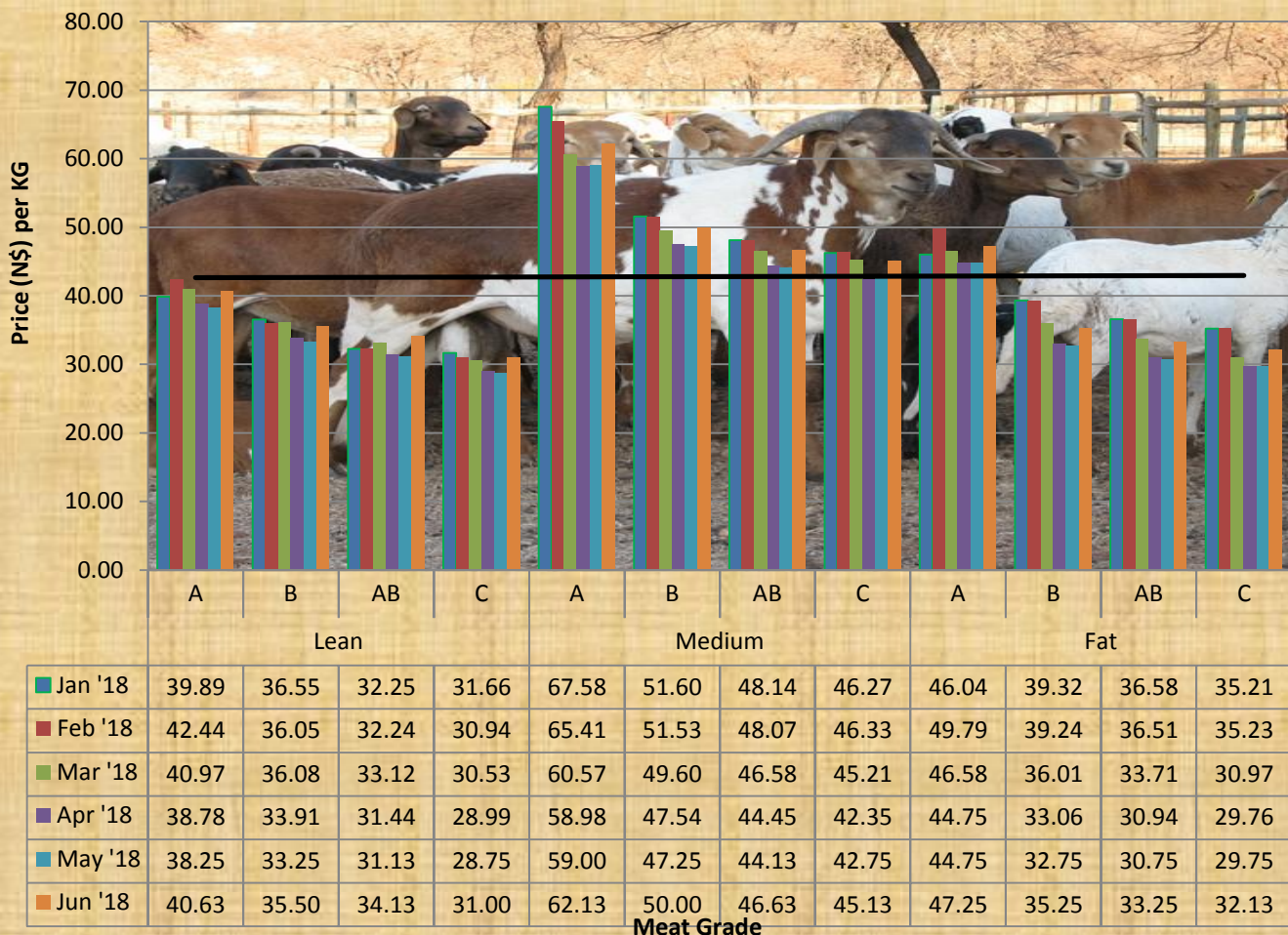
#### Average Beef Prices

**Self-Quarantined Mutton Products Delivered to NCA Abattoir**

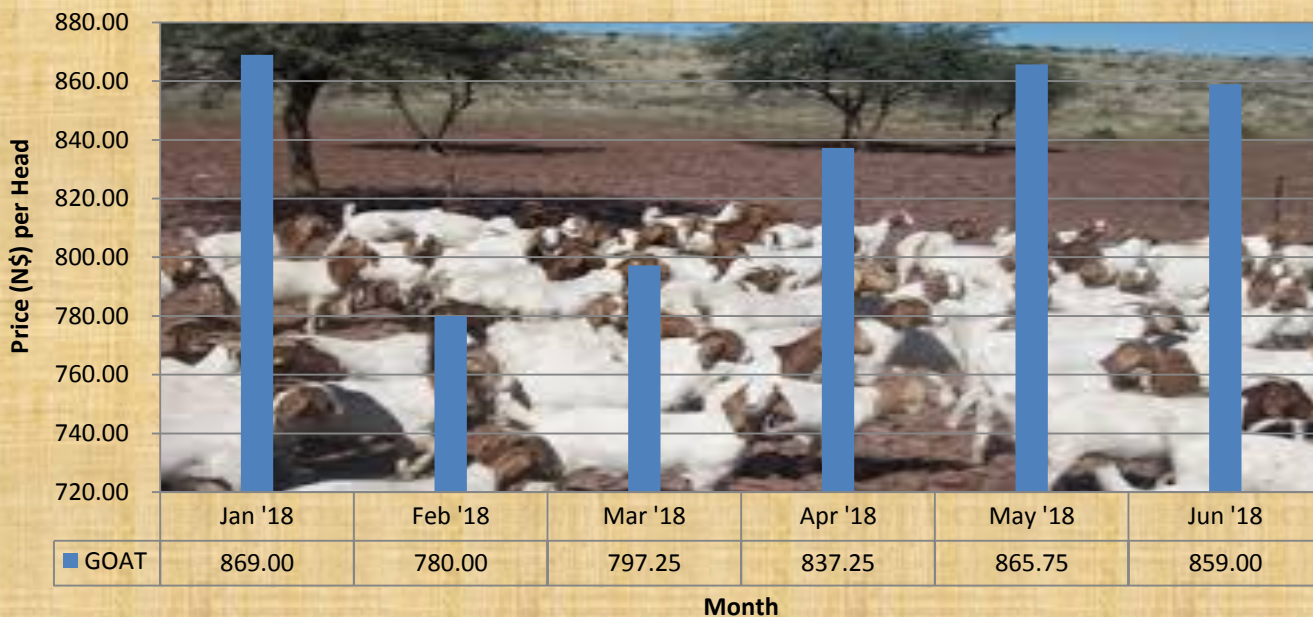
**Average Mutton Prices**

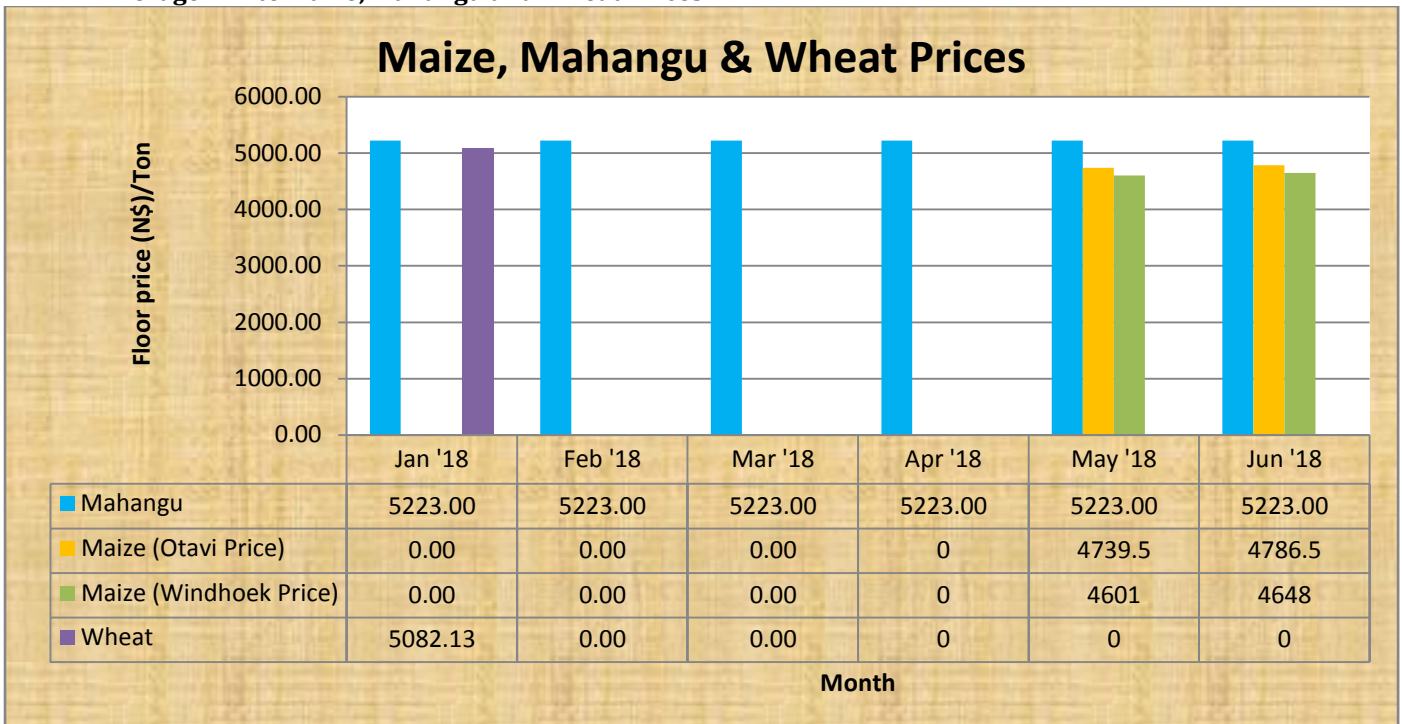
**Average Goat Auction Prices as Delivered to SNA**

**Goat Auction Prices**



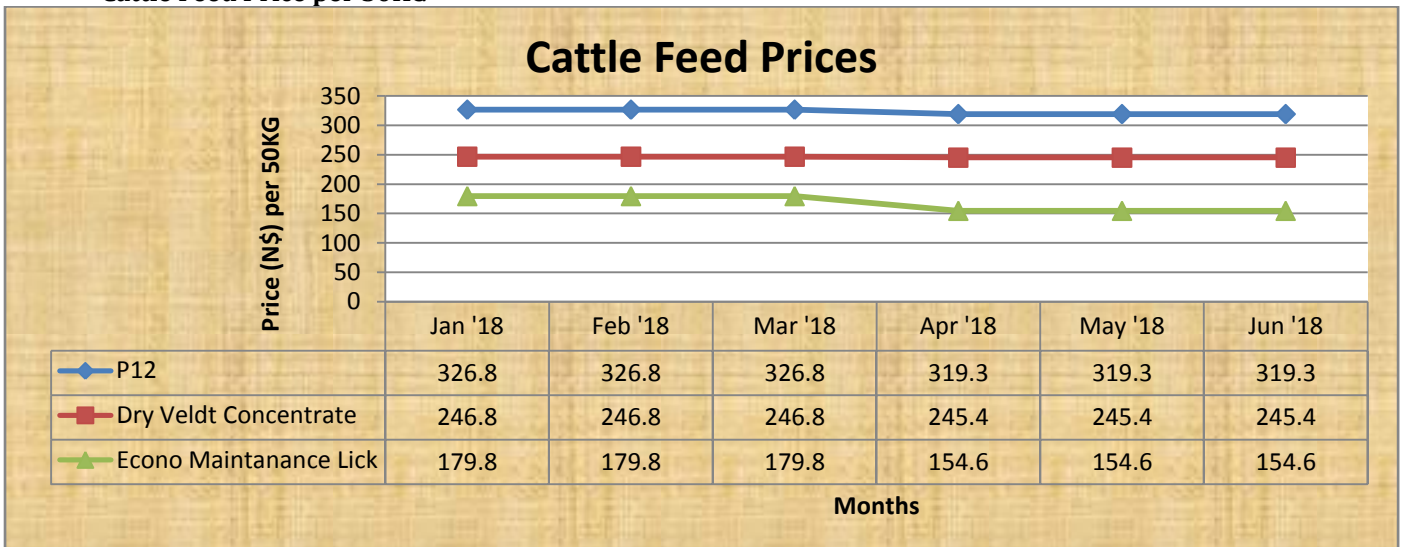

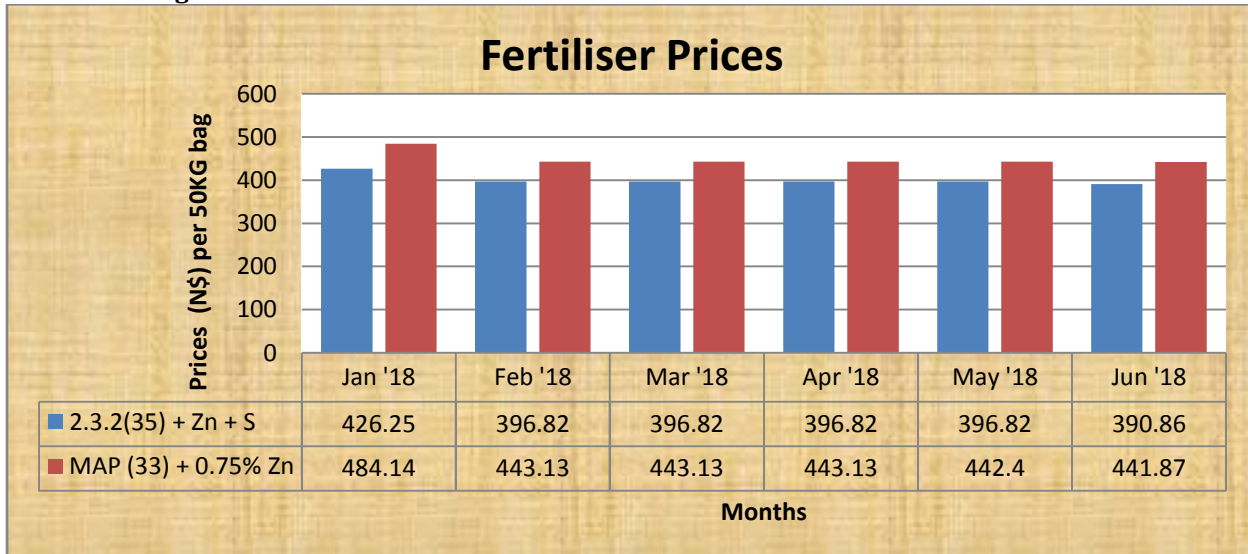
**Cattle Feed Price per 50KG**
