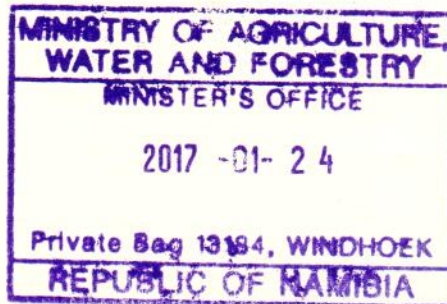

PUBLIC NOTICE: THE APPOINTMENT OF THE NEW NAMWATER BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE PERIOD 2017 - 2020.

1. Section 18 of the NamWater Act, 1997 (Act Number 12 of 1997) provides that Directors shall: "hold office for a period of three years, but shall upon the expiry of his or her term of office be eligible for re-appointment."
2. Schedule 2, Section 15 of the State Owned Enterprises Governance Act, 2006 (Act Number 2 of 2006), amends the composition of the NamWater Board as provided for in the NamWater Act of 1997 and the NamWater Amendment Act 2001.
3. Schedule 2, Section 15 of the State Owned Enterprises Governance Act, 2006, amongst others, succinctly state the following: "the Membership of the Board must include:
 - (a) a representative of the Association of Local Authorities in Namibia, designated by that Association;
 - (b) **Not less than four and not more than eight persons from the private sector, selected from amongst persons who possess expertise and proven experience in water engineering matters, consumer interests, financial, business, legal or environmental matters, so as to achieve a varied representation of interested parties."**
4. Through this PUBLIC NOTICE, I am inviting **interested and qualified persons**, as per Schedule 2, Section 15 (1) (b), quoted above, to **submit their names**, to my office, **MONDAY, 13 FEBRUARY 2017**, for possible appointment as members of the NamWater Board.

5. Submissions must be accompanied by the applicant's CURRICULUM VITAE; and should be hand delivered, emailed or faxed.
6. The current NamWater Board's term of office will come to an end on 20 February 2017.
